GIFT AID

Gift Aid is a great way to get money for nothing out of the Inland Revenue with the full blessing of the government. How it works is that when you give £1 to a registered charity they are able to claim a further 28p from the Inspector as long as you have paid at least that amount in income tax. All you have to do is fill in a form with your name and address (including post code) and tick a box to say that you wish gift aid to apply. This means that the charity can claim back the tax on all payments you make to them from that point onwards. If you are lucky enough to be paying higher rate tax you even get an advantage yourself, as a £10 gift would reduce your own tax by £2.30 as well.

£5 PER MONTH (or £60 per year - £76.80 with Gift Aid) will pay for a Team Advisor for five weeks to support a team of young people from a Special Needs School carrying out a project to benefit their local community.

£10 PER MONTH (or £120 per year - £153.60 with Gift Aid) will provide a bursary for three young people to attend a week-long residential personal development project

£15 PER MONTH (or £180 per year - £230.40 with Gift Aid) will provide a whole week of activities for a group of 13 people, including young people and people with disabilities and the volunteers who support them
